

**VERNON CITY COMMISSION
SPECIAL MEETING
September 4, 2018**

1. Call to Order:
 - A. Declaration of Quorum
 - B. Invocation
 - C. Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Douglas Jeffrey IV called the Regular Meeting of the Vernon City Commission to order at 6:30 p.m. in City Hall, and a quorum was declared present.

2. PUBLIC HEARING on the Tax Rate (second and final of two required public hearings)
Mayor Jeffrey opened the public hearing at 6:31 p.m. After allowing time for any public comments (none were offered) Mayor Jeffrey then closed the public hearing at 6:32 p.m.

Commissioner Aydelott moved to approve the Main Street Grant for 1712 Main Street. That motion was seconded by Commissioner Aydelott which then passed with a unanimous vote.
